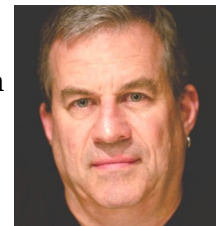
One Book, One Community:

Author Sam Quinones Visits April 27

The Pickaway County District Public Library, Berger Health Foundation and Pickaway Addiction Action Coalition have collaborated on a community-wide reading program called One Book, One Community. This year's book is "Dreamland," which discusses America's opiate epidemic.

Upcoming programs at the Main Library will be Wednesday, April 5, at 6:30 p.m. – Fighting The Drug Epidemic Together, a discussion with local law enforcement; and Wednesday, April 19, at 6:30 p.m. – Drug Treatment Options, a panel discussion.

The capstone of One Book, One Community will be Thursday, April 27, when author Sam Quinones will speak at Circleville High School Auditorium, 380 Clark Drive, Circleville. Quinones will sign books at a Resource Fair from 6 PM to 6:45 PM (books available for purchase for \$20) His presentation and question and answer session will be from 7 PM to 8:30 PM. The Resource Fair will be open until 9 PM.
