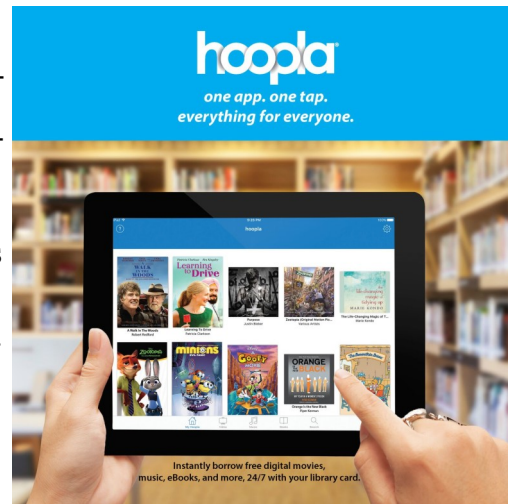
Hoopla Offers Instant Content

The Pickaway County Library is offering a new digital service to its patrons. Hoopla Digital offers music, movies, e-books, television, comics and audiobooks instantly. More than 500,000 titles are always available on this simple, intuitive platform, accessible on the library's home page.

This free service allows up to 10 checkouts per month that can be immediately streamed on a computer or mobile device. All content is available with no waiting for popular titles. Titles are automatically returned, so there are never any fees associated with this service.

On the digital app, borrowed content can be temporarily downloaded for offline use. This means you can watch movies or listen to audiobooks without using data or bandwidth – great for traveling and exercising.

Hoopla has a Kid's Mode setting, allowing young people access to content geared towards ages 12 and under. Other popular features include eReader Action View, allowing a comic book to be read panel by panel; and listening to music albums in their entirety or shuffle between other checked out albums.

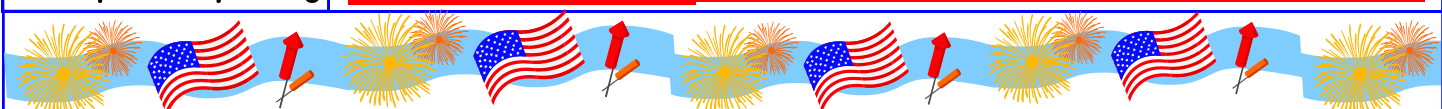

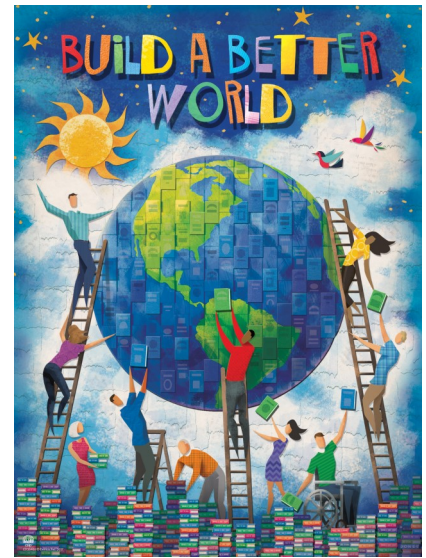
