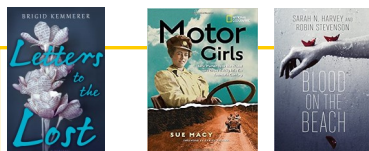


Library Open House & Health Fair Tuesday, June 6

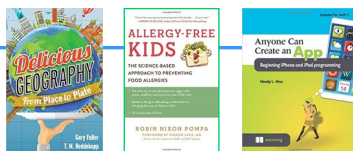
