CLC Adds Three More Libraries

As a member of the Central Library Consortium, Pickaway County Library provides its patrons access to materials from other Central Ohio libraries.

In March 2018, the quantity and variety of these materials will increase due to the addition of three more libraries. Delaware County District Library, Granville Public Library and Pataskala Public Library are joining the Central Library Consortium (CLC) in 2018. This partnership expands the number of CLC libraries to 17 members, serving 1.5 million residents across seven counties.

All CLC-member libraries have direct access to more than 3.8 million items, including books, movies and music. Patrons typically get available items from other CLC libraries 3-5 days after placing their request.

"Membership in the CLC allows us to offer our patrons access to a wide variety of items that we could not afford to purchase as a stand-alone library," says David Fausnaugh, library director. "The addition of new members will expand the depth of the consortium's collections and increase our ability to push for special projects like the capability to check out e-books straight from the online catalog, which was recently added."

One Book, One Community encourages Pickaway County residents to read and discuss "The Blue Zones" by Dan Buettner, which discusses living to be a healthy 100. Community book discussions will be held on Wed., Feb. 28 at 6:30PM and Sat., March 3 at 11 AM. More programs are on Facebook & the library's website.
