Musical Instruments Available Soon

Guitars and ukuleles are the newest edition to Pickaway County Library's collection.

Beginning March 21, Pickaway County card holders can check out an acoustic guitar or a ukulele for 21 days. Included with each instrument kit is an instruction book for beginning musicians.

"Our goal is to provide patrons with an opportunity to try out an instrument before buying," says library director David Fausnaugh.



The instruments were purchased, in part, through donations in memory of Tom Harker, a local musician, writer and former teacher who passed away in 2017. Pickaway County Library cardholders age 18 and older will be eligible to place the items on hold and check them out.

The Younkin Branch Library in Ashville hosts an open Ukulele Group on the first Monday of the month. The next meetings are scheduled for April 2 and May 7 from 6:30 p.m. to 8 p.m. All skill levels and ages are welcome.

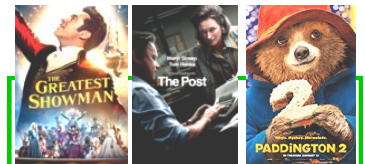
