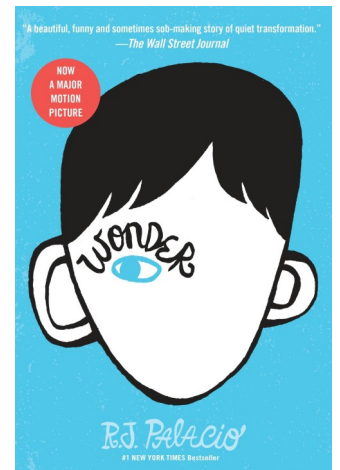
## Choose Kind with Pickaway County Library

*Wonder* is an impactful story for all ages and has been called “one of the true masterpieces of American literature” by author/director Stephen Chbosky. The book features August Pullman, a smart, funny 10-year-old boy with serious facial abnormalities. The story follows August, and those close to him, as he attends public school for the first time in fifth grade and navigates new friendships and the challenges of appearing different in the world.

One Book One Community invites you to participate in a community-wide effort to promote kindness in Pickaway County.



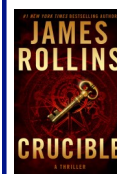
## Understanding Human Trafficking

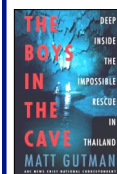
