Patrons can check out five titles a month. Kanopy is available on any computer, television or mobile device with apps for Roku, Chromecast, Apple TV, Amazon Fire Tablet, iOS and Android.

Films are from The Criterion Collection, The Great Courses, Media Education Foundation and thousands of independent filmmakers.



Kanopy Kids highlights films and TV series that inspire and inform, helping children develop empathy, mindfulness and self-esteem through entertaining and educational videos. Kanopy Kids categories include TV series, learning languages and animated storybooks. Key titles include Arthur, Babar, Franklin & Friends, Maya The Bee, Wild Kratts, Between the Lions, Little Pim, and Nigerian-animated Bino & Fino.

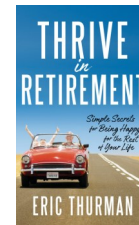

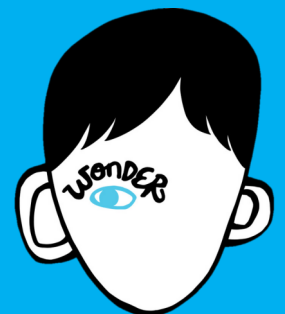
