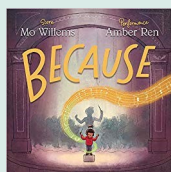

Monetary donations can be made to the Pickaway County Community Foundation, **Imagination Library Fund**, 770 N. Court St., Circleville, OH 43113.

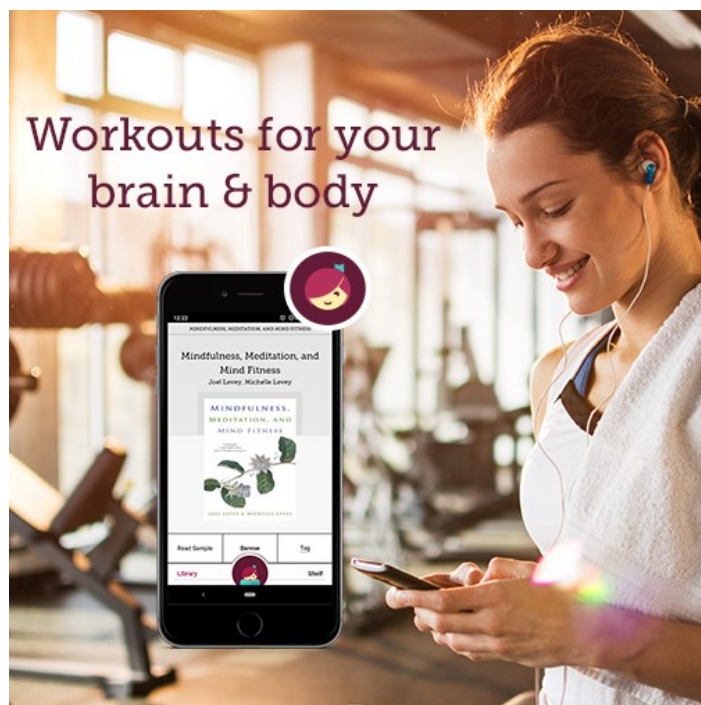


Read or Listen Wherever You Are

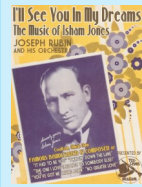
