- ❑ Install carbon monoxide alarms on each floor of your home.
- ❑ Position detectors five feet from the ground to get the best reading.
- ❑ Place detectors close enough to bedrooms so they can be heard by all in case of emergency.
- ❑ Place a detector near doors to attached garages to detect any CO that has entered your home.

REMINDE YOUR PARENTS to review your CO alarm's model specifications and be sure to learn the warning noises it makes. And remember, if your CO alarm goes off **STOP** what you're doing, **LEAVE** your home immediately and **CALL** 9-1-1.
